Pavilion and Pool Rental Information

❖ Pavilion Rental:

The small and large pavilions are each available for rental with pool membership and includes 4 hours of use (subject to availability). The small pavilion fee is \$105 for up to 30 people. The large pavilion fee is \$160 for up to 60 people. Day pass rate with rental is \$5 per person.

❖ Private Pool Party Rental:

The pool is available to rent for private parties for member and non-members. Hours are 8:15-10:15pm for up to 75 people. Fee is \$395 and each additional person over 75 is \$6 per person.

Max attendance is 125, catering menu is available, and pool requires expected attendance to properly staff lifeguards and is subject to availability.

Reminder regarding Unleashed Dogs

§85-13 of the borough ordinances that states dogs cannot run at large at any time. This is enforceable by the Code Enforcement Officer or any police officer. A complaint form could be filled out and submitted to our borough office or the non-emergency police number can be contacted to report a dog running at large.



Streetlights and Outages

If anyone sees a streetlight that is out, damaged, or not working correctly; please contact the Borough office and report the identifying number of the streetlight post. It also helps to provide the nearest property address to the defective light. The borough office will then report it to the appropriate utility company for repair.
