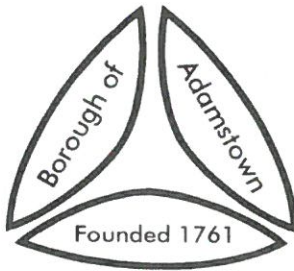

Sidewalks must be shoveled within 24 hours after the snowfall ends. Also, please clear storm drains of leaves and debris to prevent flooding when the snow melts.

Information - Education
Friendly Reminders...**

- Storm Sewer Drains— Please do your part by keeping storm sewer drains free and clear of leaves and debris. This will ensure that storm water does not pool in the streets and gutters.
- Conserve Water—Due to the process involved, it is approximately twice the cost to treat used water as it is to provide fresh water. Periodically check for leaks in your spigots and toilets. The average showerhead takes 2.5 gallons/minute so taking shorter showers will mean less water usage.
