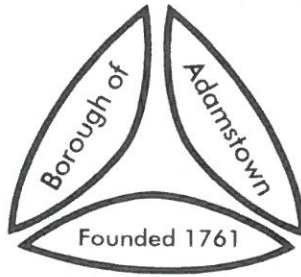

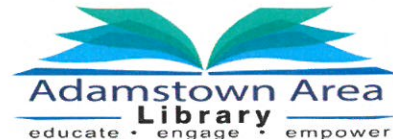
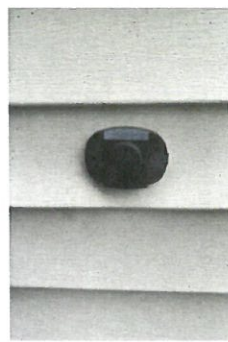


KEEP STORM GRATES CLEAR

With the abundance of heavy rainfall, storm grates are constantly getting clogged. To minimize flooding and allow stormwater to drain correctly, please be sure to maintain storm grates by clearing off and disposing of any debris covering them.

READING WATER METERS

The water meters are read via a sensor mounted on the exterior of the property (see sensor examples below). In order to get an accurate meter read, please be sure to keep the area around the sensor free of bushes, trees, plants or other items. Avoid parking vehicles, trailers or other equipment in front of the area where the sensor is located.
