

Adamstown Community Pool – 2020 Conduct and Safety Policies

Conduct Policies:

- All patrons enter and use the facility at their own risk.
- The Borough and/or the Adamstown YMCA are not responsible for any valuables or personal property brought into the facility.
- For safety, all youth age 10 and under must be accompanied at the facility by a responsible adult (age 16 & over).
- All toddlers 3 or younger must be accompanied by an in-water chaperone. Parents/Guardians are responsible for the safety and behavior of their children.
- The baby pool is open to children age 5 and younger (and only with parental supervision).
- No running or horseplay on pool deck.
- Chewing gum, glass bottles, alcohol and tobacco products (including e-cigarettes and vaporizers) are prohibited.
- The use and possession of a cell phone or any other photographic or recording device in the bathhouses is strictly prohibited.
- No foul language.
- No diving in shallow areas.
- No socializing with lifeguards or front gate staff while on duty.
- Sliding must be done feet first sitting or on your back.
- Headphones must be worn when listening to personal music devices.
- Every bag or cooler will be checked at the gate before entry. No large coolers or rolling coolers allowed. Small personal coolers only.
- No climbing or playing on the ramp.
- The only balls allowed in the pool are those made for the water.

Public Health & Safety Policies:

All patrons must sign a COVID-19 liability waiver upon first entry. The waiver will be valid for the 2020 season.

- All children age 3 or under and ANY swimmer not toilet trained MUST wear a swim diaper in the pools. Disposable diapers are prohibited. Check diapers often and take frequent bathroom breaks.
- Children or adults that have experienced diarrhea in the last two weeks should not go swimming.
- Appropriate swimwear is required; street clothing is prohibited.
- A cleansing shower (at home) prior to swimming is strongly recommended.
- Admission to the pool may be refused to any person having an open wound or any communicable disease.
- The facility will follow the guidelines of the U.S. Center for Disease Control with regard to fecal incidents, which may require clearing or closing the pool for disinfection.
- Children under 11yrs. old must pass a swim test & obtain a wristband before use of the slide, diving board or deep end of the pool.
- Floaties and/or vests are prohibited from use on both the slide and diving board.
- Only US Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices are permitted in the pool. No air-filled flotation devices (swimmies, inner tubes, rafts, etc.), snorkels or fins are allowed in the pool.
- The entire fenced-in pool area will be cleared for 30 minutes following the sound of thunder or sight of lightning. In the event of a pool closing due to weather condition, all patrons must leave the facility entirely. If the pool closes due to weather, a weather pass will be issued to punch card guests for use on a day within the 2020 season.
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Discipline Policies:

First Offense: Warning is issued.

Second Offense: The offender will be benched for a period of time by lifeguard or manager.

Third Offense: Offender will be given suspension from the pool. Time length will be at the discretion of the manager.

Bad Weather Policy:

Closings and Openings will be at the discretion of the manager. Please check our Facebook Page or Call the pool to inquire about closings. Refunds will NOT be given for early closings. If the weather is questionable, there must be a minimum of 5 patrons using the pool to remain open.

A disregard for conduct or public health policies may result in disciplinary action, up to and including suspension from using the pool by the Pool Management. Refunds will NOT be given.
