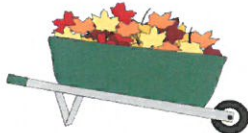

### Property Maintenance Code Crack Down

Just a reminder that Council has adopted a resolution setting fees to be incurred for various common property code violations, which will be issued via a Quick Ticket. The Quick Ticket fee is \$50 and will cover the following:

- High or Noxious Weeds or Grass (§302.4)
- Garbage and/or Rubbish Accumulation (§308)
- Animal Waste Accumulation (§302.1)
- Snow Accumulation (§302.3)

Take pride in your property and be respectful of your neighbors by keeping your property free of trash and rubbish!



### Spring Property Cleanup

To help dispose of leaf refuse left over from last fall, the borough is offering two spring leaf collection dates. Eagle Disposal will be doing a leaf collection on May 1<sup>st</sup> and May 22<sup>nd</sup>. All bags must be at curbside by midnight the night before scheduled pickups. Bags may contain only leaves. Leaf bags are available for purchase at the borough office for 25¢ per bag.
